flirt

VERB: Inflected forms: **flirt-ed, flirt-ing, flirts**

INTRANSITIVE 1. To make playfully romantic or sexual overtures.

VERB: 2. To deal playfully, triflingly, or superficially with: *flirt with danger*.

3. To move abruptly or jerkily.

NOUN: 1. One given to flirting.

2. An abrupt jerking movement.

OTHER FORMS:

flirt y —ADJECTIVE

SYNONYMS: *flirt, dally, play, toy, trifle* These verbs mean to deal lightly, casually, or flippantly with someone or something: *flirted with the idea of getting a job; dallying with music; can't play with life; toyed with the problem; a person not to be trifled with.*
